



Admissions Criteria 2022/23 for Wallace Fields Junior School

If any year group is over-subscribed, applications for entry in 2022/23 will be ranked in the following order:

1. LAC & PLAC.
2. Exceptional social/medical need.
3. Children of permanent members of staff where the member of staff has been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made; and/or the member of staff is recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage
4. Children who will have a sibling at Wallace Fields Infant School or Wallace Fields Junior School on the date of their admission and for whom Wallace Fields Infants School or Wallace Fields Junior School is the nearest school to their home address.
5. 1Children attending Wallace Fields Infant School for whom Wallace Fields Infants School or Wallace Fields Junior School is the nearest school to their home address.
6. Children for whom Wallace Fields Infants School or Wallace Fields Junior School is the nearest to their home address.
7. Other children who will have a sibling at Wallace Fields Infant School or Wallace Fields Junior School on the date of their admission.
8. Other children attending Wallace Fields Infant School.
9. Any other children. 1Criteria 5 and 8 will only apply to children who attend Wallace Fields Infant School in Year 2 and will not be applied once a child has left this school.

If the number of children who qualify under any criterion is greater than the number of places remaining available at the school, any remaining places will be offered to children who meet the criterion on the basis of proximity of the child's home address to the nearest official school gate at either Wallace Fields Infant School or Wallace Fields Junior School, with children living nearest receiving the greater priority.
