### YEAR 6 – BIKEABILITY STARTS MONDAY

All children should come into school in their school uniform and **bring their comfortable cycling clothes**, **helmet and trainers** with them to change into for the course. Training will go ahead whatever the weather so please remember raincoats and hoods. Children in the first session in the morning must arrive at **school promptly at 8.50 a.m.** for registration so that they can be ready to start training at 9.00 a.m. For the safety of all the children in school it is important that your child <u>must</u> walk their bikes from the school gate to the cycle sheds. Bicycles should be padlocked at all times when not in use, <u>please attach a named key fob to the padlock key</u>. Please ensure you have a spare key in case the children loose theirs. We advise that they should be taken home each evening, however, all bicycles are left at school at the owners risk, we cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage whilst they are on the school premises. Please spare some time to take your child out on the local roads over the weekend and check your child's bicycle and helmet using the guidelines sent previously.
