CYBER BULLYING AND USE OF WHATSAPP

At Wallace Fields Junior School we take all forms of bullying seriously and when reported to us, we are quick and decisive in taking action in the school context. As a school, we can educate and remind the children about what action to take in the event of cyber bullying, but essentially children rely on parents to monitor, control and support them in their use of social media. We ask you for your support in ensuring that every child is aware of the risk and how they should behave when using messaging and social media platforms. If you choose to allow your child to be on WhatsApp, or other applications that are meant for over 13s – we hope that you can discuss the systems in place for them to step out, report abuse or ask for help should they encounter nasty messages, pictures or audio clips. You'll need to make your child aware of the fact that they can come into contact with strangers on group chats.
