GATE OPENING TIMES

Next week the Year 6 children will be sitting the KS2 tests and we aim to maintain a calm atmosphere around the school to prevent distractions. SCARLET FEVER

We have had one child off school with confirmed and one with suspected Scarlet Fever. Scarlet fever is very infectious and can easily spread to other people. The first signs of scarlet fever can be flu-like symptoms, including a high temperature of 38C or above and swollen neck glands and a rash appears a few days later. In the past, scarlet fever was a serious illness, but antibiotics mean it's now less common and easier to treat. Children can return to school 24 hours after receiving appropriate treatment.
