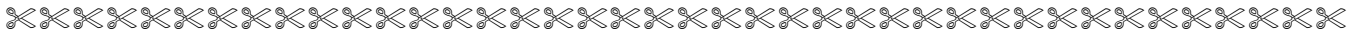
**SLIP FOR YEAR 6 – French Trip - DVD ORDERS**
