WFJS RANKED BY THE SUNDAY TIMES AS IN THE TOP 250 STATE PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN ENGLAND

In the Sunday Times last weekend, Sunday 18th November, Wallace Fields Junior School was ranked in the top 250 schools in state primary schools in England. We were ranked 229 (up from position 280 in 2017 list). Schools are ranked by the aggregated scaled scores achieved by children in reading, grammar and maths from SATs taken in 2017. No other Epsom school is listed. Our results for the 68 pupils who sat the tests were for reading 110, grammar 112, maths 109, and aggregate score 331.
