Travelling to the EU if there's no Brexit deal

If the UK leaves the EU without a deal, after 29 March 2019, you'll need:

- at least 6 months left on your passport when you travel to most EU countries
- a passport that's less than 10 years old (even if it has 6 months or more left)

REMINDERS

CHRISTMAS CARDS

There is still time for children to post Christmas cards to other WFJS children by posting their cards in the post box in the hall. Unfortunately we cannot do deliveries to Father Christmas or relatives outside the school. Cards only - no sweets, chocolates or gifts please. Please ensure children clearly mark the child's full name and ideally their class on the envelope.

PENALTY NOTICES FOR UNAUTHORISED LEAVE

The Education Welfare Service, acting on behalf of SCC may issue a Penalty Notice as an alternative to the prosecution of a Parent / Carer for their child's unauthorised absence from school and requires the recipient to pay a fixed amount. If a child is taken out of school for more than 5 days / 10 sessions, unauthorised leave, (this need not be consecutive) without the authorisation of the school, the amount payable on issue of a Penalty Notice is £60 per parent per child. This rises to £120 if paid after the 21 days period, but within 28 days. If not paid, legal action will be taken against the recipient for the period shown on the penalty notice, the local authority, Surrey County Council must prosecute the Parent / Carer for failing to ensure regular school attendance under Section 444 Education Act 1996. For the criteria for unauthorised absence and its implications please see our Attendance Policy on our websites.
