All children are expected to learn their times tables and we would encourage parents to help their child practice at home. Time tables are assessed regularly in class and certificates are awarded in whole school assembly as the children reach different levels – the certificates are Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum. Year 4 will be formally tested on times tables from May 2020 – the Government are trialling the software with chosen schools this year, with the expectation that it will be rolled out nationally next year.
