MESSAGE FROM POLICE COMMUNITY SUPPORT OFFICER RE FRAUDULENT CALLS

The Policy Community Support Officer has heard of multiple incidents recently where people have been calling up unsuspecting residents purporting to be from Her Majesties Revenue and Customs (HMRC) or the police acting on behalf of HMRC. They have stated that the **victim owes money for unpaid taxes** and have been known to quote long reference numbers and case numbers, all of these are likely to be fraudulent along with any details of officers. The Police will never ask for bank details or payments, and also would not be collecting money on behalf of HMRC. These people can be very convincing if in doubt call either the police or the company they are claiming to be from. Hang up the phone and call back on a different phone, if they don't hang up the phone their end the line will remain active. Simply call the police on 101, give over the details and they will be able to tell you if this officer is genuine or not.
