WORLD WAR 1 WORKSHOP FRIDAY 8th NOVEMBER

Education Group will be doing an interactive workshops on World War 1 for each Year Group on Friday 8th November. It will bring Remembrance day to life with an actor (Soldier Bert) talking about life in the trenches for soldiers in World War 1. Soldier Bert will discuss a range of topics with the children including how he was recruited and his training for the Great War. Replica equipment will be demonstrated and the children get involved in various drills giving them an insight into life as a soldier. Bert recounts his daily routine and describes trench life including digging latrines, the Post Office, dealing with trench foot and the rats! Each class will end the session with an old fashioned sing-song and hearing a few letters from home. To cover the cost of the visit we ask you to make a voluntary donation of **£2.00 per child on Scopay** or if you are unable to pay online then please bring in cash clearly marked in an envelope.

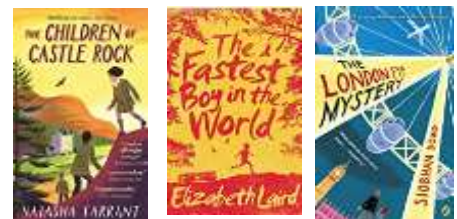
3A REMEMBRANCE DAY ASSEMBLY
