ASSESSMENT and CATCH UP

Most of the children have been completing assessments this week. This is in order to provide us with important baselines, to diagnose areas for development and to plan addition support and catch up intervention to ensure all the children are reaching their potential. The children have done well over lockdown, but learning at home is never as effective as being in class with their teacher and so the lost learning is something we must ensure we are making up for. The additional intervention is carefully planned and in the coming weeks your child may mention that they have been taught in smaller groups or had additional adult support. This is not because they have any specific special needs (those children with SEN have already been planned for), but some children will need this additional input in order to bring them up to speed or to meet 'age related expectation' (ARE) as is the teacher jargon term relating to this. Those children that were doing fine will also be monitored to ensure they are making good progress against their spring assessments. The children have all been extremely happy and positive about being back at school and the new Year 3 are doing very well. Thank you for your ongoing support and positive comments – your child will benefit from the extra encouragement and you can help them understand what that intervention is doing for them.

COLDS

We are receiving a number of calls from parents asking if their child should come into school with a cold. If your child has a mild cold i.e. a runny nose, they may attend school as normal.
