#### WORLD WAR ONE HISTORIAN VISIT - FRIDAY 6th NOVEMBER 2020

Soldier Bert is coming in on the **Friday 6th November** and will spend an hour with each year group. Bert will be recounting his experiences in the trenches and showing the children some equipment. It is a great way to bring history to life and celebrate Remembrance Day. To cover the cost of this visit, we need to ask for a voluntary donation of £2.30. # SPONSORED WALK

#### PLEASE CHECK FOR HEAD LICE

#### WINTER UNIFORM

A quick reminder that after half term children must wear winter uniform. Summer dresses and polo shirts are not permitted. If you need a school tie they are available to purchase from the school office.

#### **NASAL FLU**

Thank you to all the parents who have already completed the online form to book your child's flu vaccination on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> or Friday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2020. If you have not yet done so, please complete the e-consent form by **4 PM ON THURSDAY 29TH OCTOBER 2020** (when the website portal will close). Go to the e-consent form at:www.surreyimmunisations.co.uk Our school's unique code/URN number is SR125298 which you will need to enter on to the flu consent form. Some children may receive a letter with a bar code from NHS England once they have registered for nasal flu, which has caused confusion. **The School Nurses at NHS Child Health are not collecting the bar code**, so please be reassured that you do not need to send it into school, and our process has not changed.

#### **WATERBOTTLES**

Please remember to bring in water bottles every day. All water bottles must be labelled with an indelible marker. The owners initials are enough.

# WATCHES AND FITBITS/HEALTH TRACKERS

Watches must be removed for PE & games. A simple cheap analogue watch is recommended in order to promote the learning of time (rather than digital watches). Fancy watches and health tracker watches can be a distraction and we would like to discourage children from wearing high cost items in school. The school takes no responsibility for these items in school and they remain the responsibility of the wearer.

A child in 4D lost their pink Fitbit on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> October so if anyone finds it please let Miss Day know.

#### **RAINY DAYS**

Please remember to send your child in to school with a good quality waterproof coat with a hood as children will have breaks in light rain and may also need to wait for their year group to enter school at the set time in the morning.

#### PENALTY NOTICE FOR UNAUTHORISED ABSENCE

Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority, they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices. Please find more details in the attached letter.
