YEAR 4 - TAG RUGBY TEAM TRIALS STARTING FRIDAY 12th JANUARY

HEAD LICE ALERT

We have been notified of head lice in Years 4 and 6, so please ensure you check your child's hair this weekend for signs of lice or nits. Please wash hair and smother in conditioner while wet, then comb through with a fine tooth comb to entrap the lice. Once the comb is clear of lice or nits, wash hair and repeat every four days for two weeks. Unfortunately, this does take time, especially for children with long hair and it will be necessary to treat the whole family.

PENALTY NOTICES FOR UNAUTHORISED LEAVE

A full copy of our Attendance Policy is available on our website. The following paragraph highlights the most important change: **PENALTY NOTICES** The Education Welfare Service, acting on behalf of SCC may issue a Penalty Notice as an alternative to the prosecution of a Parent / Carer for their child's unauthorised absence from school and requires the recipient to pay a fixed amount. **If a child is taken out of school for more than 5 days / 10 sessions, unauthorised leave, (this need not be consecutive) without the authorisation of the school, the amount payable on issue of a Penalty Notice is £60 per parent per child.** This rises to £120 if paid after the 21 days period, but within 28 days. If not paid, legal action will be taken against the recipient for the period shown on the penalty notice, the local authority, Surrey County Council must prosecute the Parent / Carer for failing to ensure regular school attendance under Section 444 Education Act 1996. Please read the **Attendance Policy** to ensure you understand the criteria for unauthorised absence and its implications. **Mr Lee, Headteacher**
