Coat

Clearly named outdoor coat of your choice (with a loop to hang up on a peg). A coat must be brought to school every day.

Jewellery

Permitted jewellery that may be worn is:

- One pair of stud earrings no other piercings are permitted
- A smart and sensible wrist watch

It is advisable that children do not wear jewellery to school on PE days. If they cannot remove stud earrings then they must come to school with them taped over.

Nail varnish and make-up must not be worn for school.

Medications

If you need school staff to administer any medication to your child(ren), please ensure this is handed in at the school office; this is for safeguarding reasons. We will need you to send in a 'Request to Administer Medicines Form', which can be completed at the office or we can email out to complete at home and return.

This message applies to <u>all</u> medications, including Piriton. Could we also ask that should you need us to administer any 'over the counter' medication, please send a bottle in, as we only hold a small supply, which is for emergency use only.

A reminder that we can only administer medication if it is required <u>more than 4 times a day</u>, in line with our current policy.

School Gateway

As per our previous messages and letters, this is to advise all parents that Walmsley will no longer be able to accept cash or cheque payments for trips, school dinners or school item purchases (such as book bags, DVD's etc). This will apply directly after the Autumn half-term, 6th November onwards.
