London Trip Onboard Luggage



SMALL rucksack for onboard the coach containing:

Food:

- Good packed breakfast we eat this at a service station. Children are not allowed to buy anything at this time.
- Big packed lunch for Monday we eat this at the museum.
- NO NUTS OR CHEWING GUM
- Drinks: see slide coming up
- Snacks: see slide coming up
- A <u>small</u> pillow or cushion to help them sleep!
- Things to do... book, magazine, cards/games, puzzle book, notepad... NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES
- A waterproof coat
- MAXIMUM £50 spending money in a named wallet/purse for souvenirs to be handed in to their group leader (on the coach journey)
- £10 cash for the service station tea on the Thursday evening to be handed in to their group leader (on the coach journey)
