YEAR 3 VISIT TO THE MANCHESTER JEWISH MUSEUM

We will be taking our Year 3 children to visit The Manchester Jewish Museum on Monday, 13th May.

The Museum hold over 31,000 items in their collection, and documents the story of Jewish migration and settlement in Manchester. The collection is considered by historians to be of national and international significance, and is described as a place to experience how we are different, together.

Your child should wear school uniform for the trip. Please ensure they are sent with suitable footwear and a coat with a hood in case of rain, for moving to and from the coach

A packed lunch will be provided by school for children who usually have school meals. Those on sandwiches should bring a packed lunch as normal, in a named carrier bag which can be thrown away after lunch (no reusable bottles please – disposable ones only). All children may bring extra drinks (non-fizzy please) and snacks (PLEASE REMEMBER – NO NUTS OR NUT-BASED SNACKS).

To help cover the cost of the coach journey we ask for a contribution of £21.50 – to be paid by 3^{rd} May 2024, please.

Payment should be made via School Gateway, which will also provide permission for the visit. We are no longer able to accept cash or cheques in school; should you wish to make payment this way, please contact the school office and we will be able to provide you with a PayPoint Voucher.

We will be leaving at 9:00, so can children please be at school for 8:45, and we aim to leave The Museum at 14:30 – to be back at school in time for normal collection.
