Each part of the whole word is spelt as it would be on its own  | If the verb ends in two consonant letters (the same or different), the ending is simply added on.  | The past tense of some verbs sounds like it ends in /ɪd/ (extra syllable), /d/ or /t/ (no extra syllable).<br>If the verb ends in two consonant letters (the same or different), the ending is simply added on. | If the verb ends in two consonant letters (the same or different), the ending is simply added on.  | The prefix un- is added at the beginning of a word without any change to the root word.   |
