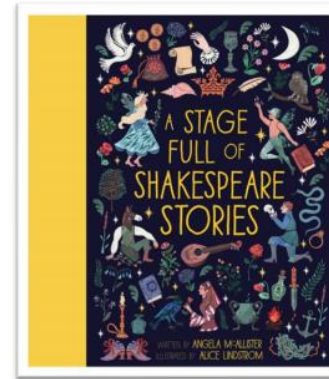

## Genre: Fiction – Play Scripts

**I am learning to write play script for part of the story.**

**Greater Depth:** To rewrite part of the story as a playscript including omens and use weather descriptions to reflect the mood.

Play Scripts include:

- Write brief descriptions of role/personality to introduce characters in a glossary
- Use sub-headings to show where the action is taking place
- Open each scene with a short paragraph describing the setting
- Write the name of each character on the left-hand side of their dialogue using a colon
- Use brackets for stage directions before dialogue
- **Include fronted adverbials in stage directions where possible (Y4)**

## Grammar objectives in Year 3 Writing Summer 2

**(Please see the Year 4 Grammar Booklet for an explanation)**

- Extend the range of sentences with more than one clause by using a wider range of conjunctions (including: when, if because, although)
- Group related ideas into paragraphs
- Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently, including the progressive form and the present perfect form
- (Consolidate punctuation covered so far)

## Non Negotiables in Year 3 Writing Summer 2

- Use punctuation correctly - full stops, capital letters, excl. marks, question marks, commas for lists & apostrophes (Y2)
- Use subordination (when, if, that, because) and coordination (or, and, but)
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify
- Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently
