Greater depth writing outcome: To write own version of the story including the point of view of the giant character

Fiction writing includes:

- Use phrases from story language
- Create and describe characters
- Create and describe settings
- Sequence of events
- Section story into beginning, middle and end
- Use 3rd person consistently
- Use tenses appropriately

Non Negotiables in Year 2 Writing Summer 2

- Use subordination (if, that)
- Add -er and -est to adjectives
- Use homophones and near homophones
- Use punctuation correctly – apostrophes for contracted forms

Grammar objectives in Year 2 Writing Summer 2

- Use present and past tenses correctly and consistently including the progressive form
- Use subordination (using when, if, that, or because) and co-ordination (using or, and, or but)
- Use expanded noun phrases to describe and specify
- Add suffixes to spell longer words e.g -ment,- ful
