## Maths

In Maths, we will continue to study and progress with our times tables. We will be working on our understanding of time, length, perimeter and capacity during our measurement units, as well as deepening our understanding of fractions to be able to find fractions of an amount.

# History

This term in History, the children will be studying The Romans. We will be learning about why the Romans invaded Britain and what life was like in Roman Britain.

# Geography

In Geography, we will continue to explore our locational knowledge while studying. Italy. We will be looking at where it is located and the key physical features that make up the landscape. We will also find out about its capital city, currency and language.

### Science

First, we will study Light; light sources, reflection, shadows and the sun. We will also be studying Plants. We will look at germination and fertilisation and the life cycle of a plant, as well as conducting our own experiment to see what is most important for a plant's grow.

### Art

This half term in Art, children will be creating observational drawings of plants, focusing on tone and texture. Their final piece will be an abstract drawing inspired by Georgia O'Keefe.
