What are we learning this term?

Maths

Over the summer term, children will be looking at time, decimals, money, position and direction and statistics.

There will also be an emphasis on TTrockstars in preparation for their end of Year 4 multiplication timetables check.

Pupils will also complete a weekly mental maths test in class and daily calculations to support their fluency in the four methods of calculation.

History

Our history topic this term focuses on Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons. The children will learn about what life was like for them and how the Vikings conquered the Anglo-Saxons.

Geography

In geography, children will be learning about world countries. They will research how to use lines of longitude and latitude and how to plot coordinates.

English

We will start the Summer term by studying the story 'Invasion' and exploring different settings, We will then be reading 'Operation Gadgetman' by Malorie Blackman giving children the opportunity to develop their retelling of a story skills and then progress onto their independent story writing.

Science

Throughout the Summer term children will be studying and investigating living things and their habitats. Children will also be learning sound. They will understand that sound is created when an object vibrates and that sound can travel.

Art/DT

In art, children will be studying mega materials. They will be looking at a range of materials in order to carve and explore 3d sculptures.

For DT, we will be focussed on textiles where children will be creating their own cushions.
