Headteacher's Message

Parents collecting students from school will no doubt have noticed the police presence outside school. Unfortunately, we have had threats of violence made to some of our students outside of school. Most of these have been from students from other schools. Lancashire Police have supported us this week with a much-increased presence, and this will continue in a more discrete manner moving forward. I realise that this can be alarming to parents, however we felt we needed this support to send a very clear message that aggressive behaviour and threats of physical violence towards our community will not be tolerated.

Please can we remind parents that eyelashes and fake nails are not permitted. We recognise that students are gearing up for Christmas parties, but can we please appeal to parents to make any appointments for the afternoon of Friday 22nd December!

We are currently working towards a conversion date of 1st February for our conversion to an academy and joining Aspirational Futures. We have secured a significant amount of additional funding towards school improvement because of academisation. This will support in the funding of a secure fence around the school perimeter, revision programmes for year 11 students and other additional resources for the school including more 3D printing facilities, textbooks and laptops as well as increased leadership roles within the school. We have a new school website which will be launched in the new year and several updated policies. I will continue to use the bulletin to keep you up to date with these. In the meantime, I need to alert you to the updated privacy notice for pupils available on the school website, linked here.

The Governors have approved the holiday dates for the next academic year and they can be found on our website here.

Just a reminder that school will close to students at **12.30pm next Friday 22nd December** and will reopen on Monday 8th January 2024.


