How do I find work experience?



Start to research potential work placements:

- Speak to family or neighbours do they have any contacts, or are there opportunities where they work?
 Ask what jobs they do? Does it sound like something you'd like?
- If you have a part time job that you enjoy, ask if there is a different role in the company you could try
- Google local companies and make a list of any that sound interesting - find out who the manager is
- Visit some potential employers and ask if they accept students for work experience
