We are looking to recruit additional invigilators to work alongside an experienced team.

Experience of invigilation is not required as training in the role and duties will be provided.

Hours: Availability required in January for Year 11 Mock Exams (2-3 weeks) and through May/June for Year 11 GCSE's and Year 10 Mock exams.

Rate of pay: £12.00/hr

The role

- o Invigilators are the people in examination rooms responsible for conducting exams and supervising candidates, in accordance with the JCQ (Joint Council for Qualifications) and awarding body regulations
- o Have a key role in upholding the integrity of the external examination/assessment process
- o Must confirm the confidentiality and security requirements surrounding the invigilation process are known, understood and will be followed at all times

An ideal candidate will

- · be reliable, flexible and available during main examination periods
- have effective communication skills and good interpersonal skills
- work well as part of a team
- · be a confident and reassuring presence to candidates in examination rooms
- be able to give instructions and manage situations involving different groups of people
- have basic IT skills (familiar with use of email, mobile phone messaging etc.)
- seek to achieve competence in the role and a thorough understanding of the JCQ regulations
