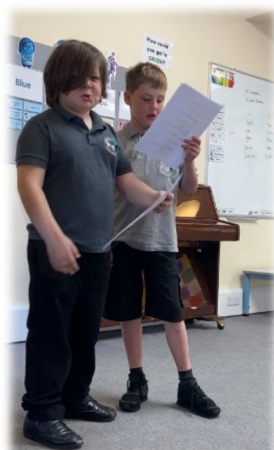

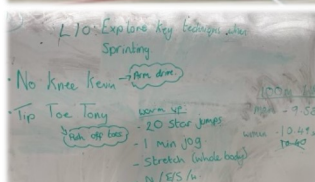
Year 10 : Sports Leaders

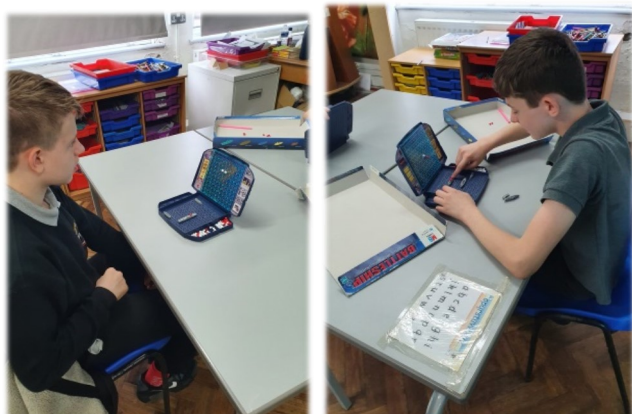

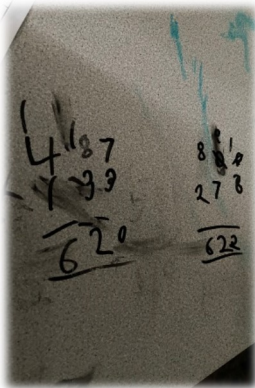
