SCIENCE



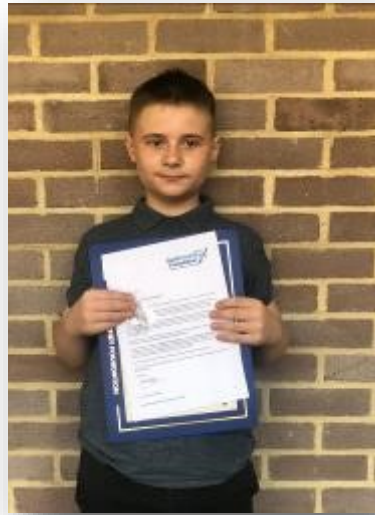
The Year 7s enjoyed the PTSCA Science session on classifying rocks for a new playground surface. Going to look great with a solid Rose Quartz on .

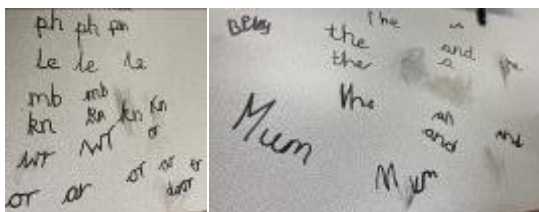
