Pupils in full engagement in a speed sounds session—fantastic learning!





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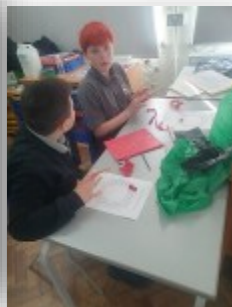
Remembrance Day
