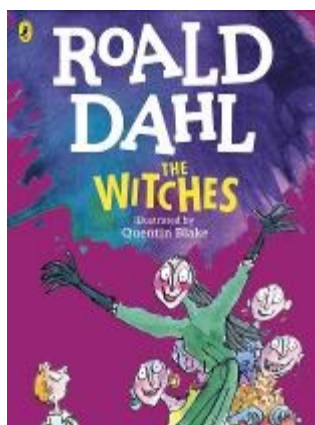

Year 7s working hard on their English writing moderation task

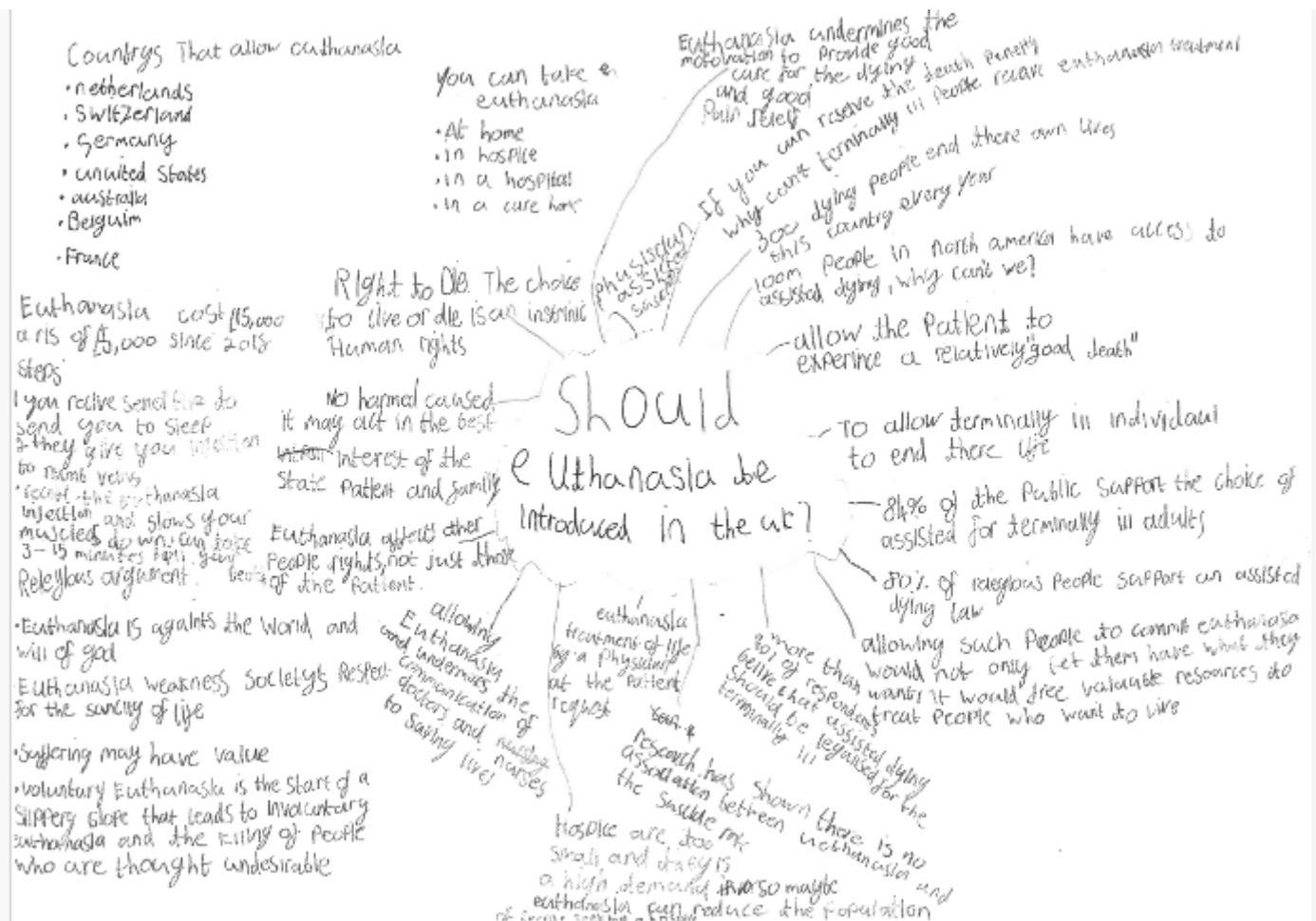


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Year 11 English
