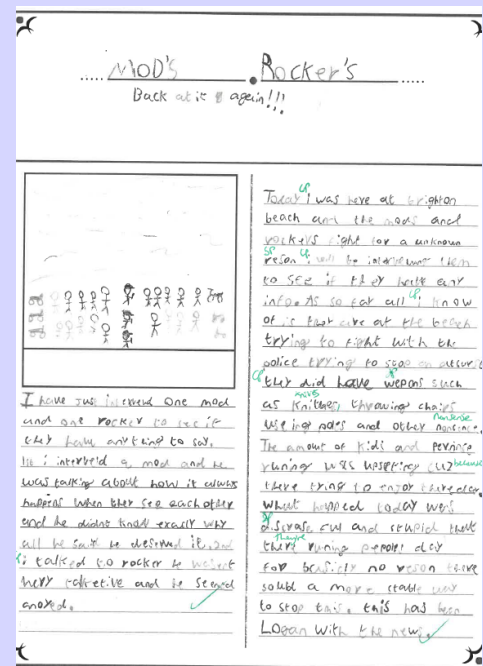
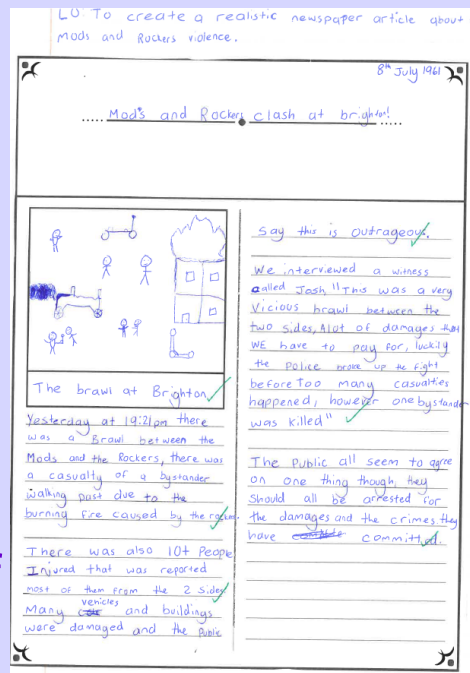
A glimpse into ICT classes for Primary and Year 7

Really pleased with the work that LT and TE created capturing the writing style and adding some great details of interviews with the public.

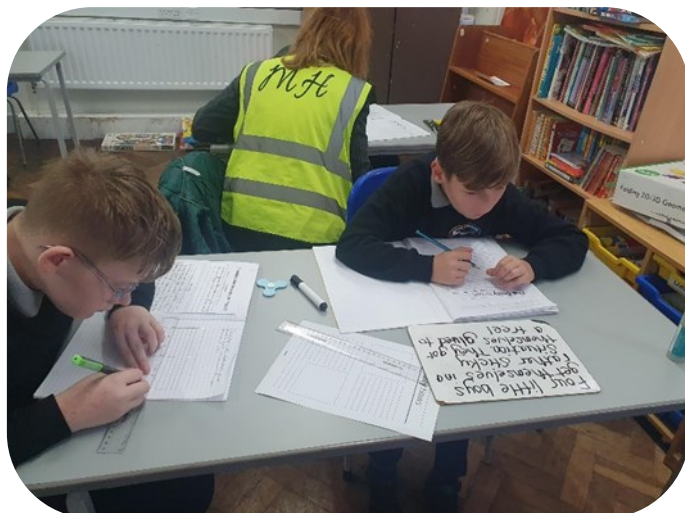




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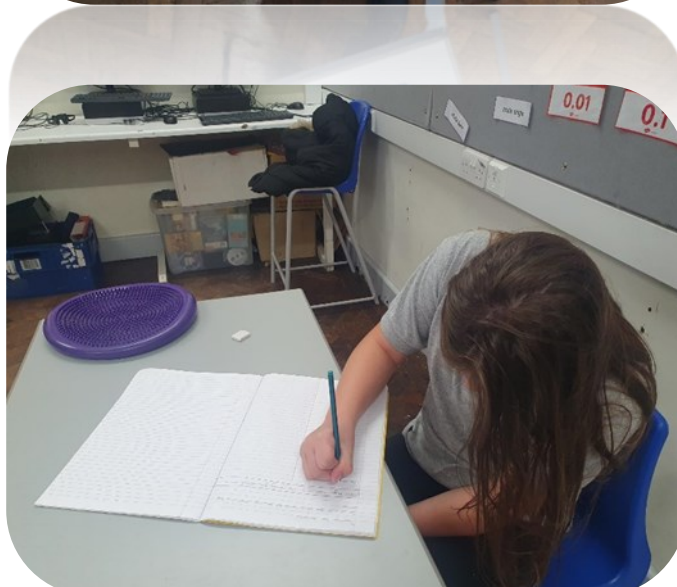
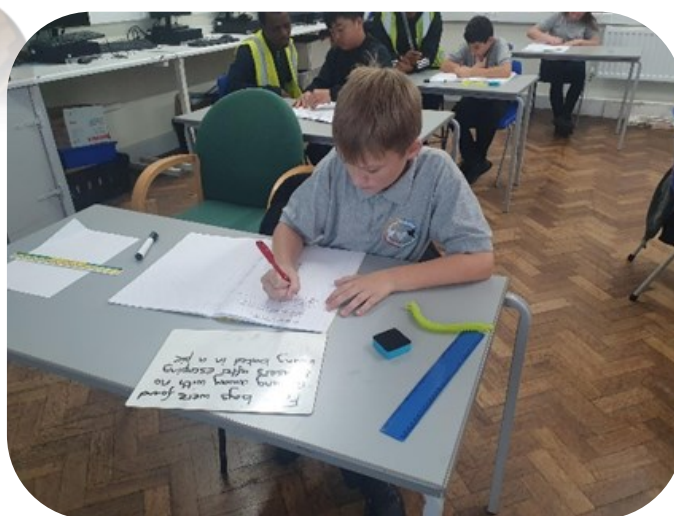
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English Lesson
