Please pass on my thanks to them and to their teachers for taking the time to come along to this important event in our calendar.

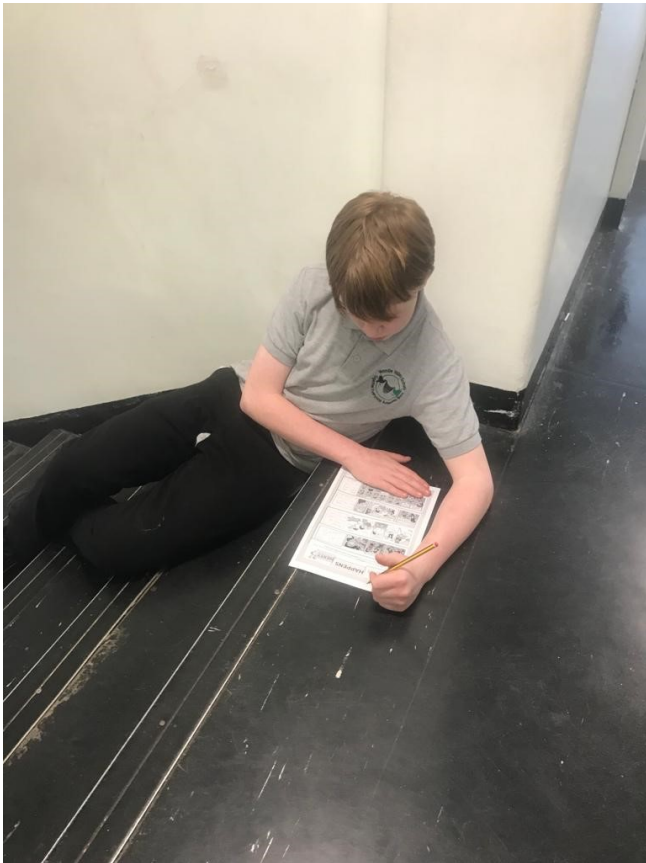

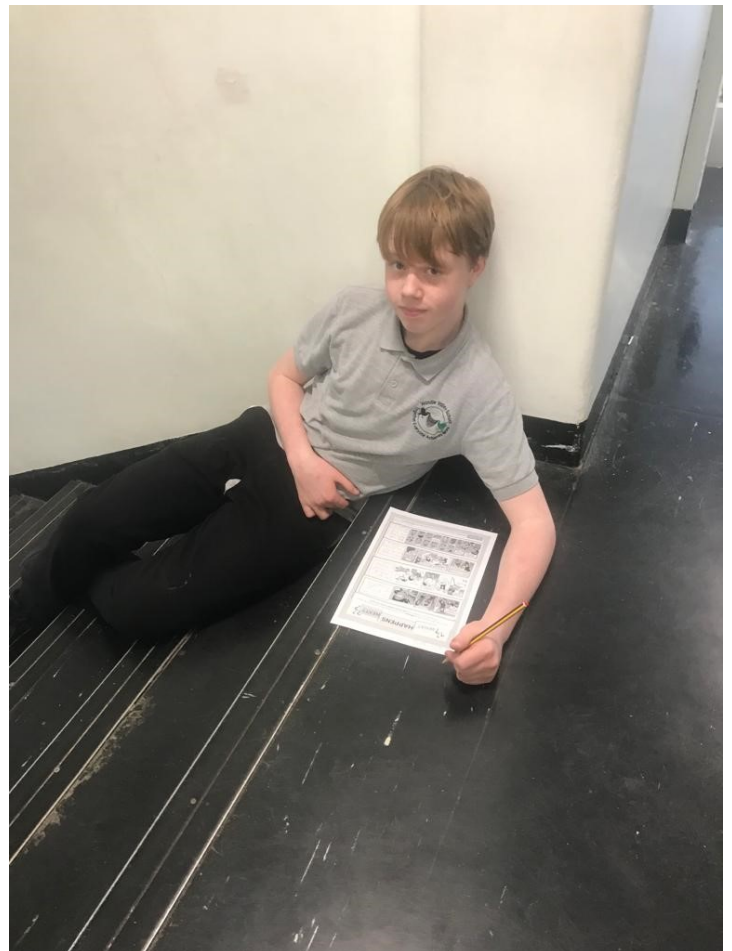
