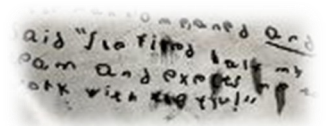

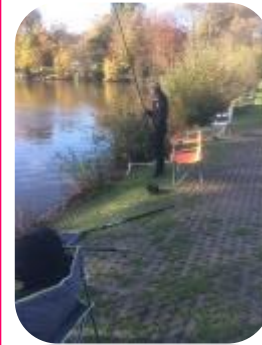
Each student designed a piece on paper and recreated it in water-based clay using specific tools and

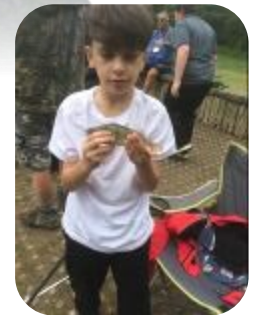
