If you require a supporting letter or statement for your application, please let us know and we would be happy to provide that for you. Or if you would like help with completing the application we are also able to offer that.

We have been continuing to offer the reduced provision in school to a small group of pupils each day since 30<sup>th</sup> March. Over this time, there have been numerous versions of Government guidance and advice, information and requirements from South Gloucestershire, and from other sources including unions, and our Health and Safety advisors. We have also been constantly monitoring, evaluating, and reviewing the reduced provision to ensure that the wellbeing of pupils is prioritised.

We know from speaking to families that many of you are feeling a sense of turmoil about sending your child back to school if they are eligible for a place from 15<sup>th</sup> June. You are not alone, please talk to us about your worries. We are going through consultations with governors, staff and unions and have produced an extensive risk assessment and guidance. Ultimately, it is your decision and you can choose to keep your child at home until September if you think it is the right choice for you and your family, this is perfectly acceptable. Equally though, we are looking forward to welcoming pupils back from mid June, so if your child is eligible for a place and you would like to take up the offer, we would like to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to ensure their safety when they return.
