Topic (Geography) - Our Planet

- To locate the Equator and the Northern and Southern Hemispheres on a mworld/globe.
- Climate and physical environment at the equator is different from the rest of the world.
- To identify lines of longitude and know that they run over the top of the earth from north to south (they are not equally distant from each other)
- To identify lines of latitude and know that they run round the earth from east to west and that they are the same distance apart (they run parallel to the equator)
- To understand that there are 24 different time zones on earth, all start at Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)

Science - Light

Explore how light travels in straight lines to explain how objects can be seen because they
give out light or reflect light into our eyes.

Explain how we see things.

Explore how shadows have the same shapes as the objects that cast them because light travels in straight lines.

Music

- Be able to identify the difference between live and digital sounds.
 - Explore how music is created using Digital Audio Workstations.

Art - Still Life

- Explore the work of Paul Cezanne, understand the artistic style of still life and be able to talk about its features.
 - Use sketches to record their observations of the work and share their opinions.
 - Experiment with the techniques used including using drawing and painting.
- Use chosen techniques to create a still life piece of art and give their reasons for their choices.
