Please choose *five different activities* to do.
Remember, we will be looking at content, research, presentation, handwriting, effort and what your homework can teach the rest of the class.
Homework is to be in school at the latest by:

Record a news report outlining the ten plagues of Egypt and the impact these had on the Pharaoh.

Looking at our Gospel Value of Hope, write a list of your hopes for 2023.

Make a poster to help children learn basic first aid.

Create a menu that could be used in a French café.

Create a comic strip featuring the main parts of the story of Exodus.

Record a journal on the shape of the moon over the space of a week: what do you notice?

Create a grid containing shapes and ask someone at home to find their co-ordinates.

Write a setting description for a Science Fiction narrative.

Draw your own version of Klimt's 'Tree of Life,' using your own symbols of choice.

Create a model of the planets in our solar system – try to keep to scale as much as possible.

Research a famous astronaut and create a fact file about their life.

Design your own task – check it out with your teacher!

Using what we have learned about seismic activity, create a structure that could best withstand a severe earthquake.

Research a major volcanic eruption that has happened and explain the impact that it had on the world.
