Paul was a man of perseverance. He was a zealous persecutor of Christians before his dramatic conversion on the road to Damascus. After his conversion, Paul became one of Christ's most dedicated and tireless apostles. Despite facing numerous hardships, including shipwrecks, beatings, imprisonment, and eventually martyrdom, Paul never wavered in his mission to spread the Gospel. His letters to the early Christian communities, many of which were written during his imprisonment, make up a significant portion of the New Testament and continue to guide and inspire Christians today. Paul's life demonstrates a profound example of perseverance in the face of adversity...

#### REMINDERS FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE


#### **Absences**
