Our Gospel Value this half term is Love.

RE

This term we will be looking at the Easter story Key Questions

What do you think is the most important part of the Easter Story?
In what way is the Easter Story about new life?
How do you think people feel when someone they love has died?
How does the life cycle of a butterfly reflect the events of Easter?
In what way is Easter a new beginning?

Maths

In Maths this term we will be learning to:

- Recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher.



- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for: lengths and heights [for example, long/short, longer/shorter, tall/short, double/half], mass / weight, capacity, volume and time.
- Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

English

We will be looking at Traditional tales with a twist based on The Three Little Pigs. We will be looking at The Three Little Pigs, The Three Horrid Pigs and The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig.

Phonics

In Phonics this term we are carrying on learning our Phase 5 sounds. We are also looking at alternative spellings for our Phase 5 sounds.

Science

We will be looking at everyday materials. We will be looking at objects and what they are made from. We will be able to name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

P.E

PE will be every Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon but this might change depending on other activities we are doing in class.

Please ensure your child's PE kit is in school everyday.

Children can wear a white t-shirt, black leggings/joggers or burgundy shorts, a black hoodie/jumper or their school jumper/cardigan. They can wear trainers for PE but please ensure they are velcro fastening if they are not able to tie laces.

Please make sure all items of clothing have name labels.



History

This half term we will be learning all the first flight. We will be learning when the first aeroplane flight took place and who the Wright brothers were.

Design Technology

This half term we will be looking at food and nutrition. We will be looking at where food comes from and what makes a healthy diet.

Computing

In Computing our unit this half term is Lego Builders, where we will be continuing to look at coding.

Weekly Spellings
