RE

This term we will be looking at Christmas

Key Questions

Why do people give and receive gifts at Christmas?

Why is Jesus described as a gift?

How does it feel when you give and receive gifts?

What is the best gift you have ever received?

Maths

In Maths this term we will be learning to :

- Recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- Measure and begin to record; lengths and heights, mass/weight, capacity and volume and time (hours, minutes, seconds).
- Recognise and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes.



English

This half term we will be reading Toby's Great Fire of London.

In our writing we will be focussing on ensuring that we can use finger spaces between words, capital letters and full stops. We will also be looking at using question marks and using 'and' in our sentences.

Phonics

In phonics this term we will be continuing to learn new Phase 5 sounds. We will then start to look at alternative spellings for all the sounds we have learnt.



P.E

Mr Evans will be teaching PE for us every Tuesday Afternoon.

Please ensure you have a full indoor and outdoor PE kit in school every week.

PSHE

In PSHE our topic this half term is anti-bullying.

Science

In Science we will be looking at seasonal changes. We will begin to observe the changes within the four seasons and describe the weather associated with each season and how day length varies



History

In History we will be learning all about The Great Fire of London.

Art

In Art this half term we will be focusing on sculptures. We will be looking at lots of different designers and then designing our own sculpture.



Computing

This term in computing we will be continuing to use Purple Mash with a focus on coding.

Home-School Partnership

Daily Home Learning

School reading book to be read every night and journal signed by an adult.

Weekly Spellings

Each week your child will be set spellings to learn for the following week. Spelling tests will be on a Thursday, with new spellings given out on Fridays. These words will be based on the work we are doing in the classroom that week.

Each half term your child will receive some different open-ended project tasks to be completed by a given date. The projects will be based on the topics we are doing in class and will be designed so that they can be completed together.
