


Pearl Class Spring Term One Newsletter

RE

This term we will be thinking about our friends and what makes a good friend. We will also be looking at stories about Jesus and his Disciples.

Key Questions
What does special mean?
Jesus was special. How? Why?
What made Jesus special?
Who were the special friends of Jesus and how did they try to follow his teachings?
How do we make and build friendships?

Maths

In Maths this term we will be learning to:

- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than, most, least.
- Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction.
- Describe position, directions and movements.



English

We will be looking at different Pirate stories this half term. We are continuing to ensure we are using finger spaces, full stops and capital letters in our sentences. We will be writing our own message in a bottle from a Pirate.

Phonics

In phonics this term we are carrying on learning our Phase 5 sounds. We are also looking at alternative spellings for our Phase 5 sounds.

Science

We will be looking at animals this half term. We will be identifying which animal group different animals belong to, describing them and looking and what food they eat.

P.E

Mr Evans will be teaching PE for us every Tuesday Afternoon and Friday Morning.

We will be working on dance and gymnastics this half-term.

PSHE

This half term our topic in PSHE is 'Being my best'. We will be looking at how we keep our bodies healthy.

History

In History we will be learning all about Christopher Columbus and famous.

Music

This term our topic focus is 'How does music make the world a better place?' We will be introducing tempo and dynamics.



<u>Art</u>

In Art, we will be looking at painting, using texture and making collages and making a landscape picture combining these skills.

Computing

In Computing we will be looking into pictograms.

Weekly Spellings

Each week your child will be set spellings to learn for the following week.
