PALS (Playground Leaders) equipment and training (increase existing equipment amount due to staggered playtimes and lunchtimes)	£279.90	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children in Year 5 and 6 to be trained to lead play and games on the playground • Leaders to be provided with training, equipment and resources they can use to support the play of younger children • Intended outcome: Children to be supported and engaged at playtimes and lunchtimes to improve behaviour and ensure children are being more active. • Intended outcome: To give older children in school more responsibilities.
Resources and Equipment to support the teaching of Forest Schools, afterschool clubs and active playtimes	£1500	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Update and replenish outdoor wear for EYFS Forest School • Provide teachers with equipment for afterschool clubs • Intended outcome: To ensure all children have the equipment and provision for Forest School.

Staff and Children's Wellbeing (Gardening club and gardening area)	£600	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher and member of dinner staff to be responsible for setting up and maintaining an area of the field to make a garden. • Groups of children at lunchtime, afterschool and for nurture can use the area to help to maintain it. • Promotes well being by giving children and members of staff a quiet place where they can reflect and spend time in nature – in light of recent time spent away from school some children and adults might be suffering with anxiety. • Intended outcome: To support the well-being of children and adults and encourage outdoor activity.
Improve and develop the outside provision for Sport (PE curriculum and after school clubs).
