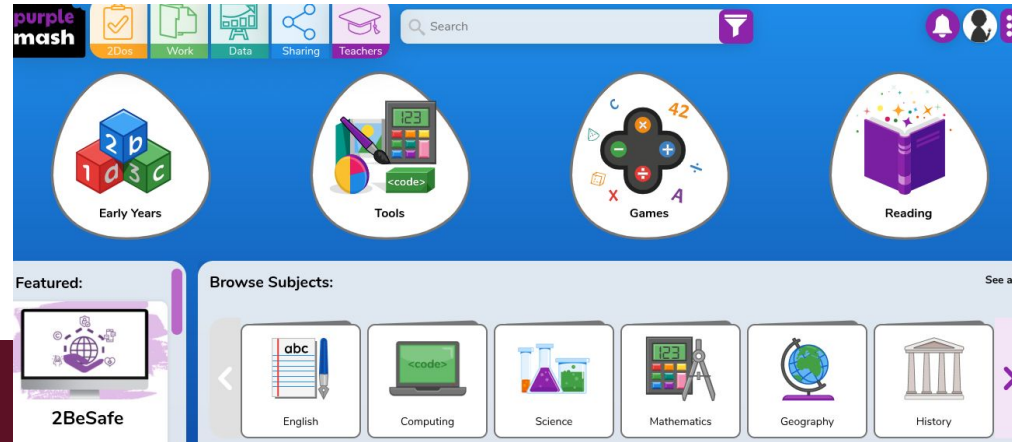
INDEPENDENCE

HOMework

Children will be sent home with a book each day to share with an adult at home. This book will be changed weekly.

Children will practice reading in school, so it is important they bring their book each day.

Listening to your child read at home is a powerful way to support their learning. By actively listening and asking gentle questions about the story or characters, you help build their confidence and deepen their comprehension skills. A few minutes of shared reading and conversation makes a significant difference in their progress.

MTC Window Opens: Wednesday 9th June 2027

What is the MTC?

- An online check taken in Year 4.
- Tests recall speed of multiplication tables up to **12 times 12**.
- Pupils get **6 seconds** per question to type their answer.

Practice at Home with Times Tables Rock Stars!

Building speed and confidence is easy with daily practice:

-  **Soundcheck Mode:** Uses the exact same format as the official MTC (25 questions, 6 seconds per question).
 -  **Garage & Studio:** Perfect for learning trickier tables and earning coins.
 -  **Daily Goal: 5–10 minutes a day** makes a huge difference!

HOW MUCH LEARNING TIME IS LOST?

Being late might not seem like much, but it adds up!

5 MINUTES LATE EACH DAY



= **25 MINUTES** LOST A WEEK

= **1 HOUR 40 MINUTES** LOST A HALF TERM

= **3 HOURS 20 MINUTES** LOST A YEAR



10 MINUTES LATE EACH DAY



= **50 MINUTES** LOST A WEEK

= **3 HOURS 20 MINUTES** LOST A HALF TERM

= **6 HOURS 40 MINUTES** LOST A YEAR

BEING PRESENT

Being present helps your child connect, learn, and grow. Every session counts – for their progress and future.



IMPACT OF ABSENCE ON LEARNING



3 DAYS ABSENCE
(= 6 SESSIONS)

= **18 HOURS**
(illustrative)



- = almost 1 full week of lessons missed
- = **over 1000 minutes** of direct learning lost (illustrative)
- = impact on understanding following learning



5 DAYS ABSENCE
(= 10 SESSIONS)

= **30 HOURS**
(illustrative)



- = more than 1 full week of lessons missed
- = significant learning gap to bridge
- = **over 1800 minutes** of missed instruction (illustrative)



10 DAYS ABSENCE
(= 20 SESSIONS)

= **60 HOURS** (illustrative)

- = almost 2 full weeks of instruction lost
- = substantial knowledge gaps that are hard to fill
- = **over 3600 minutes** of direct instruction missed (illustrative)
