Topic (History)



- Ancient Maya
- To recall and organise relevant facts about the Maya civilisation.
 - To understand the important aspects of Maya religion.
 - To understand how the Maya number system works.
- To identify and use a range of evidence sources to help me understand more about the Maya civilisation.
- To explain what the Maya writing system consists of, how words are constructed and what codices are.
- To describe a range of foods that were eaten by the ancient Maya people and explain why certain foods were particularly significant.

- To know what gravity and resistance are and identify balanced and unbalanced forces and to compose scientific enquiry questions.
