Non- Fiction : Skeletons and Muscles (a non-chronological report)

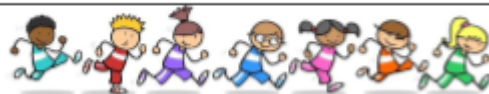
Daily no nonsense spellings

Half Termly

Each half term your child will receive some different creative open-ended project tasks to be completed by a given date. The projects will be based on the topics we are doing in class and will have instructions about what we want your child to do and how we want them to present it.

We would encourage you to support your child and work together on the projects, where necessary, and the children will then share their projects with the rest of the class once they are completed.

All homework will be on the school website for you to access and our class page will be updated frequently so you can see what we have been learning and experiencing in class.

If your child cannot complete their homework for any reason, please don't hesitate to contact us in school. If your child doesn't hand in their homework on time without a reason from a parent/carer they will be expected to complete the work at lunchtime.
