Create a poster about our current British Value of Mutual Tolerance.

Looking at our Gospel Value of Peace, research and make a fact file on a winner of the Nobel Peace Prize.

Write an onomatopoeia poem about bonfire night.

Create a Christmas card in French.

Create a leaflet explaining how Christians prepare for Christmas.

Research and answer the question: Why was Alfred the Great so great?

Practise conversions between fractions, decimals and percentages.

Write a setting description for a place in Oliver Twist. Use descriptive and figurative language.

Choose a Christmas decoration you have at home and evaluate its effectiveness, based on our DT work.

Design a poster explaining what happens when fuels are burnt and how people can use less energy.
