9:00 - 9:30	Zoom 1	<u>Phonics 10 mins</u> Teach new sound (trigraph) 'ure' Real Words: sure, lure, insure, pure, cure, secure, manure, mature, picture
9:30 - 10:30	Activities	Practice writing 'ure' (on paper, in the air, on the floor) Play Word Detectives. Write the words above on small pieces of paper and hide them around your house. Find them, read them and write them down without looking. <i>Additional Activity: ure activity mat</i>
10:30 – 11:00	Zoom 2	<u>Maths 10 mins</u> Number line mistakes How many cubes do I have? I have more, how many could I have? I have fewer, how many could I have? Model dominoes game, number in the centre, put the dominoes in more or fewer columns.
11:00 – 12:00	Activities	Using dominoes you have at home, or the ones on the sheet; place a number up to ten in the centre and place the dominoes either side for more or fewer. <i>Additional Activity: Write numbers to 10 on small pieces of paper. Choose a number, say it and then guess if the next number is more or fewer than the one you have chosen.</i>
12:00- 1:00	Lunch	
1:00 – 1:30	Zoom 3	<u>Pirates - 10mins</u> <u>Story focus: The pirates next door</u> Where have the pirates gone on their next adventure? Who will they meet there? What do they do while they are there? Together, plan a three part story. Model writing a sentence or a caption for each part to create our stories.
1:30 – 2:30	Activities	Make your three part story for where the pirates go on their next adventure. Draw where they go, who they meet and what they do. Write a short sentence or caption for each picture you draw. Children use phonic knowledge to write the words they think of.
