9:00 - 9:30	Zoom 1	<u>Phonics 10 mins</u> Teach new sound (digraph) 'er' Real Words: her, verb, kerb, fern, flower, term, boxer, finger
9:30 - 10:30	Activities	Practice writing 'er' (on paper, in the air, on the floor) Play Word Detectives. Write the words above on small pieces of paper and hide them around your house. Find them, read them and write them down without looking. <i>Additional Activity: find the tiny er words sheet</i>
10:30 – 11:00	Zoom 2	<u>Maths 10 mins</u> <i>Starter:</i> Counting forwards to 20 (focus on teen numbers) <i>Main:</i> Making 9 Using 9 objects - share between two or three groups. Say how many are in each group, then how many there are altogether. How many ways can we make 9?
11:00 – 12:00	Activities	Get two plates or three plates and 9 objects. Find as many different ways you can to make 9. Draw a picture using 9 of the same object e.g. a train with 9 wheels, or 9 flowers in a pot. <i>Additional Activity: Colour the towers in different ways to make 9</i>
12:00- 1:00	Lunch	
1:00 – 1:30	Zoom 3	<u>Pirates - 10mins</u> Story: Jake's first day. Together, go on a treasure hunt and create a treasure map. Talk about directions and positions.
1:30 – 2:30	Activities	Make your own treasure hunt and instructions (using pictures). Draw where the next clue is hiding using arrows e.g. a table, with an arrow pointing down. Draw a treasure map to show where the clues are hiding and where the treasure is.
