

Handprint Hug Card

If you are missing a friend or a family member and want to let them know that you love and are thinking about them, then why not send a special hug in a card? Simply follow the instructions below to make your very own and post it to somebody you love.

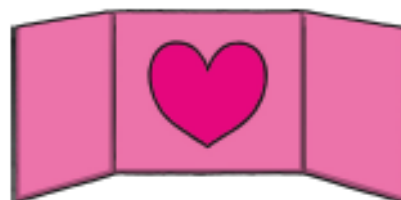


You will need:

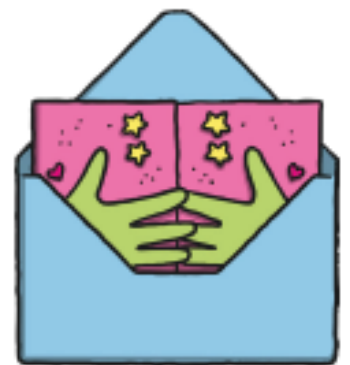
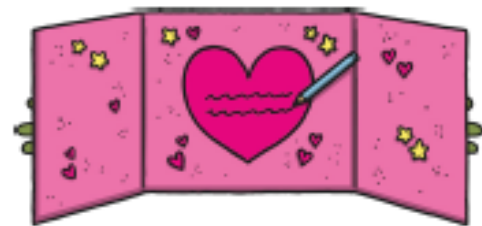
- A4 coloured card
- A4 coloured paper
- felt-tip pens/colouring pencils
- scissors
- heart template
- glue stick

Instructions

1. Turn the A4 coloured card landscape and fold the two edges of the paper inward so that they meet in the middle to create an open door effect.
2. Cut out the heart template and colour it in using felt-tip pens or pencils.
3. Stick the heart onto the middle of the inside of the card so it appears when you open the card 'doors'.
4. Using coloured paper, draw around both of your hands then carefully cut them out using scissors. You may need an adult to help you.



5. Take the two hand cut-outs and place each one on the front of the card 'doors' so that the wrists are in-line with the folds. When you close the 'doors' on the card, one hand should fold under while the other rests on top (see picture). When you are happy with the position of the hands, apply some glue to secure them in place.
6. Leave the glue to dry before writing a message inside the card.
7. Send this huggable card to someone special!



Top Tip: Why not add a photograph of yourself poking out of the top of the heart to make it even more personal?
