Remember, we will be looking at content, research, presentation, handwriting, effort and what your homework can teach the rest of the class.

Draw a cartoon strip ordering the key events of Ascension and Pentecost. Write underneath each picture what is happening.

Research a person who has displayed our Gospel Value of perseverance and create a fact file about them.

Draw a timeline of key events from our class novel 'Holes.'

Draw a poster about the pets you have using French vocabulary.

Research and create a presentation about the Amazon rainforest.

Write a newspaper report about an exciting event that has happened in your life-remember to use all of the agreed features.

Measure the size of the walls of a room in your house and calculate its area and perimeter.

Write some lyrics for a new song. Remember that songs have verses, a chorus and sometimes a bridge.

Design and draw an optical illusion using what we have studied this half term in Art.

Perform an experiment on the best way to separate a mixture of water and salt. Write your results up.

Create your own algebraic problem using symbols instead of numbers and see if someone else in your house can solve it.

Design your own task – check it out with your teacher!

Write an explanatory text about how reversible changes happen, use what we are learning about in both Science and English to help you.

Create a tourist brochure about Brazil and why someone might want to visit it. Include key landmarks, history, its capital, climate and time zone.
