Put them into five pairs and make a number sentence for each pair to compare them using one of Chomp's signs: < or >.  For example, 15 < 32	Have a go at one of the activity sheets on the website.	Play <b>Flip it!</b> with your grown up, using number playing cards or dominoes. Flip over one card each. The person with the greater number gets a point. When the cards are gone, count the points.
