

Maths	<i>To use arrays to show multiplication</i>	<p><u>Year 1:</u> Counting in fives word problems – see website</p> <p><u>Year 2:</u> Colouring arrays – see website</p>	<p><u>Year 1:</u> Repeated addition cubes – see website</p> <p><u>Year 2:</u> Roll two dice and use the numbers to draw an array, for example: If you roll a 4 and a 3, draw a box that is 4 rows of 3. Can you choose two habitats and draw and label one food chain you would find in each one?
