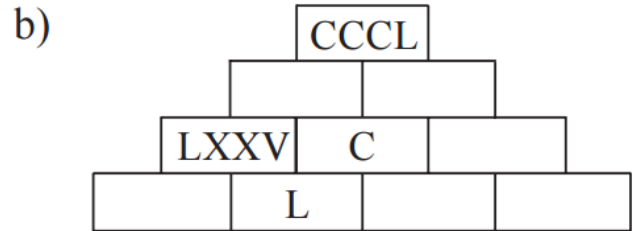
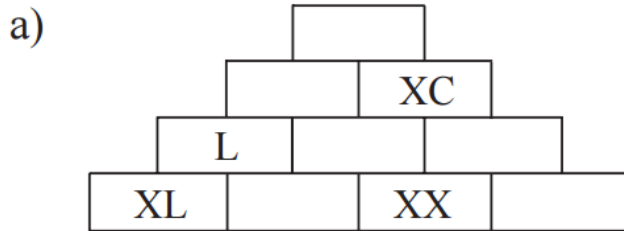

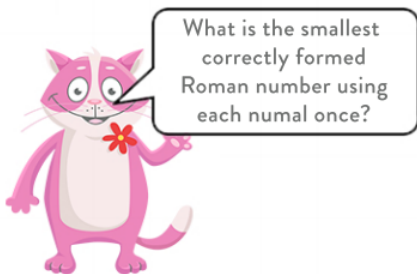

There are seven letters used as Roman numerals:

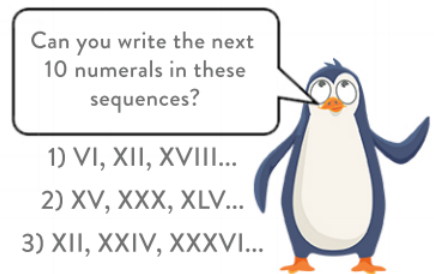
I = 1 V = 5 X = 10 L = 50 C = 100 M = 1,000
